LERU Doctoral Summer School 2014

- Place:** University of Helsinki, Finland
- Time:** 14-18 July 2014
- Topic:** “Doing the right things right” – Research Integrity in a Complex Society
- Theme:** Research Integrity
The Summer School is focused on mapping the terrain of ethical issues in research in order to prepare participants with a holistic understanding of the complexities of ethical decision-making in an international context with an appreciation for researching with integrity.
- Who can attend?** Outstanding doctoral candidates from all academic disciplines and various cultural backgrounds
- being keenly motivated to work on the topic,
 - being preferably well-advanced with their PhD project and
 - being fluent in written and spoken English
- Costs:** 500,- Euro including course, course materials, accommodation and meals (breakfasts, lunches and one evening reception) and up to 200,- Euro (travel expenses)
both will be funded by IGA
- Program:** It will be a **student-centred approach** in which participants are encouraged to engage in problem solving and discussion. It will be a **combination of keynotes, workshops and group work**.
Prior to the summer school, **participants are asked to submit a short essay on key ethical issues in their research project.**
