LERU Doctoral Summer School 2011

- Place:** University College London, Great Britain
- Time:** 17-22 July 2011
- Topic:** Essential Enterprise Skills for Early Career Researchers
- Theme:** Entrepreneurship
Participants will develop the knowledge and attributes required to successfully take a business idea forward, whether that is within an academic or a business environment and from scientific or humanities domains.
- Who can attend?** Outstanding PhD candidates
from all academic disciplines and various cultural backgrounds
- being keenly motivated to work on the topic and
 - being preferably well-advanced with their PhD project
- Costs:** 375,- GBP (including course, course materials, accommodation and food)
And up to 200,- Euro (travel expenses)
both will be funded by IGA
- Program:** It will be a **combination of initial training and project work** in **cross-disciplinary teams** on a **business idea** focused around one of the global challenges (climate change, energy, ageing, population growth, urbanisation or food security). **Experts** in areas such as intellectual property and resource management will be on hand to **support the teams** in their work.
At the end of the week, **each team will present their business idea** to a panel of professionals. During the business plan development, participants will be encouraged to produce a video diary of their activities.
