Information on the scholarship	 Period of funding: 1 October 2014 to 31 December 2014 1000 EUR per month, plus child allowance for parents
Target group	Doctoral candidates of the University of Freiburg
Prerequisites	 Qualified university degree Outstanding qualifications Dissertation project that is expected to result in an important contribution to research Acceptance as a doctoral candidate at the University of Freiburg As an exception, doctoral candidates who have already received a scholarship from a funding organization for 36 months may apply
Submission period	4 September 2014 – 30 September 2014, 4:00 p.m. The IGA receipt stamp applies! Applications submitted later will not be considered.
Application documents	Please check to make sure your application is complete and includes all required documents. Your application must be submitted by post or handed in personally at the IGA.

Application documents for applicants who did not a receive an LGFG scholarship:

- Application form
- Description of your dissertation project (12 pages max.), including your previous academic achievements, an account of work on the project you have already completed, and a schedule for future work, especially for the funding period October to December 2014
- A letter of recommendation from the supervising professor, junior professor, lecturer, or other person authorized to supervise dissertation projects and who is a member of the University of Freiburg. The letter of recommendation must be sent directly to the IGA by the reviewer or included with your application in a sealed envelope
- Curriculum vitae
- Certificate of acceptance as a doctoral candidate from your home faculty

- Higher education entrance qualification (school-leaving certificate)
- University examination certificates (intermediate examinations)
- University diploma (certified copy)
- Declaration of income in lieu of oath
- Any documents providing evidence of academic achievements, relevant practical experience, and qualifications earned at or outside of the university (if applicable)
- Birth certificate of child and family registration certificate (if applicable)

<u>Application documents for applicants who received an LGFG scholarship:</u>

- Application form
- Short description of the state of work on your dissertation project and a schedule for future work, especially for the funding period October to December 2014
- A statement on your application from the supervising professor, junior professor, lecturer, or other person authorized to supervise dissertation projects and who is a member of the University of Freiburg. The statement must be sent directly to the IGA by the reviewer or included with your application in a sealed envelope
- Declaration of income in lieu of oath
- Birth certificate of child and family registration certificate (if applicable)

Only complete applications will be passed on to the commission for consideration.

Please make sure your application is complete before submitting it.
