

Self-Organisation for PhD Candidates

Target Group

The workshop is targeted both at PhD candidates at the beginning and in the middle of their research. PhD candidates further progressed may gain better understanding of self-organisation useful in all areas of professional life and a better idea of the final steps of finishing the PhD thesis.

Content

The one day workshop covers the topics crucial in the course of writing a PhD thesis, starting from scratch through all intermediary stages until the final publication of the actual thesis. The workshop will introduce the "6-Phases-Modell of Gaining a PhD" which helps organising the complete course of writing and gaining a PhD.

Aim

The aim of the workshop is to achieve better self-organisation before, during and after the doctorate.

Methods

The instruments proposed in the workshop will include methods of reflection, tools for planning and self-organisation as well as "learning by doing" in practice sessions.
