



## Publishing Research Articles: Strategies and Steps

### Target group

Doctoral candidates and postdoctoral researchers in the natural sciences and life sciences. Postdoctoral researchers in the faculty of medicine are not permitted to participate at the workshop.

### Goal

The aims of this workshop are to understand the steps in the publication process and to develop individual strategies for publishing research articles.

### Content

- The peer review system: stakeholders, processes, benefits, criticism
- Journal selection: criteria (e.g. journal reputation, decision time) and strategies
- Publishing in open access journals
- What editors want
- How to respond to editor's comments
- What reviewers do
- How to write a review report by yourself
- What to do in case of rejection
- Authorship
- Copyright issues
- Ethical obligations

### Methods

Short lectures provide information and tips; extended exercises help to develop individual strategies. In addition, participants share experiences and discuss recommendations.

**In preparation of this workshop, participants select three journals relevant for their field of research. For each journal, they bring to the workshop information about: (1) aims and scope, (2) reputation, (3) editors and editorial staff.**
